# BEN SALEM VOICE - February 2019

Ah February, a month we love to hate. I guess in its defense we could say it is kind of the 'hump month.' Like hump day we can think of February as the month that gets us closer to the month when we will 'March' into spring. Each year winter begins just before the celebration of Christmas which means it begins without much of a thought as we are distracted by the advent of Christmas. January is the first full month of winter and we do our best to grin and bear it as our souls are still filled with the Christmas spirit. But February is the month when many start turning their thoughts to warmer days. Our spirits begin to run low as the dreary days seem to drag on and on. I think many people would just as well skip the month of February (I apologize if you have a birthday or anniversary during this month) and get on with March so we could move into the invigorating season of spring.

Somewhere along the way though it was decided that maybe we could make February a month that could have a focus on love. Although some nay-sayers might say Valentine's Day was created by the flower shops and the Greeting Card industry to promote their businesses, others may remind them that the day was actually meant to honor two Christians both with the surname Valentine who had been martyred during the persecution of Christians in the Roman Empire.
