## IN CASE OF FIRE/EVACUATION INSTRUCTIONS

In the event of a fire or the need to evacuate the building, the following procedure will be enforced:

- 1. A whistle will be blown and fire alarm will be raised by breaking the glass at a designated point
- 2. Playgroup Manager to dial 999 and request Fire Brigade to attend a fire at either:
  - St Catherine's Community Centre, School Lane, Didsbury, M20 6HS
  - Ladybarn Community Centre, Royle Street, Fallowfield, M14 6RN
- 3. Person who blew the whistle to pick up register
- 4. All remaining staff to gather and guide children out of the fire door whilst singing "The Grand Old Duke of York"
- 5. Playgroup Manager to check toilets and kitchen
- 6. Staff and children assemble in the main car park, away from the fire and any hazards
- 7. Headcount of children, staff and volunteers to be carried out twice, and checked against the register
- 8. Await the Fire Brigade

We have a fire drill once every half term, which we record on our Fire Drill form. We enter the date of the fire drill, number of children present, number of adults present; time the fire drill took place, the time taken to evacuate the building and the reaction of the children.

All of the Centre's fire extinguishers are checked on a regular basis by a designated company and the labels on them are signed and dated. The fire doors are also checked regularly to ensure they are in working order. There is also a fire blanket located in the kitchen.
