## Staying Healthy...Keeping Germs at Bay

Young children are building their immune system. They will be ill from time to time in spite of our efforts to provide a healthy and clean environment for them. Please plan a back-up-system, i.e., care for your ill child when you must work and can not be at home.

To prevent the spreading of illness to other students, as well as the teachers, please adhere to the following:

**FEVER:** Your child should not be brought to school until they have been fever free for 24 hours.

**VOMITING:** Your child should not come to school if he or she has vomited more than once in the preceding 24 hours.

**DIARRHEA:** Your child should not come to school, if during the preceding 24 hours, he or she has had more than two episodes of watery stools or inability to get to the bathroom in time.

**STREP THROAT:** Your child should not return to school until he or she is fever free and has been on antibiotics for 24 hours.

When your child is absent, please notify the school on the day missed. If your child is at school, and he or she should be well enough to participate in all activities.

## **OF SPECIAL INTEREST**

**We want your children to make the most of their day at Early Years Preschool. Please dress your child appropriately for the weather. Do not send your child in cowboy boots, crocs or any other open toed shoes. Also make sure that any toys, expect for soft sleep buddies are left at home.**
