Dr. Leanne Regehr - Senior Piano, Vocal/Choral/Speech Arts/Musical Theatre



Leanne Regehr is a versatile and sensitive pianist who has captivated increasingly diverse audiences across North America. She is the featured soloist in a live recording of Victor Davies' *Mennonite Piano Concerto* with the Winnipeg Symphony Orchestra, and is currently based in Edmonton where she serves on the faculties of the University of Alberta and The King's University.

Leanne's reputation in opera has grown through engagements as a répétiteur with Shreveport Opera, Mercury Opera, and Edmonton Opera. Her dedication to the development of young

singers has been shown through her work as a faculty member with Opera NUOVA, a staff pianist for Sherrill Milnes' VoicExperience Program in Florida, and as a Coaching Fellow at the Aspen Music Festival. She is widely recognized for her intuitive ability to collaborate with other musicians across an extensive range of repertoire.

Leanne completed her Doctor of Music in Piano Performance at Northwestern University and explored further studies at the Banff School of Fine Arts, the Universitat Mozarteum in Salzburg and the Aspen Music Festival. She is the accompanist for the Richard Eaton Singers and freelances as a soloist, vocal coach, recital partner, and adjudicator.

Sheryl Bowhay specializes in instrumental music education, and has taught bands, orchestras, and choirs at the elementary, middle school, and high school levels in Alberta and Ontario, Canada. Ms. Bowhay has actively participated on committees and boards at the local, provincial and national level. Sheryl served various roles on the Alberta Band Association, including President in 1995-1996, she was the founding President of the Ontario Band Association, and is currently Past President of the International Bandmasters Fraternity, Phi Beta Mu. Ms. Bowhay has been acknowledged for her leadership in teaching and the fine arts and was recently honored by the Ontario Band Association with an Honorary Lifetime Membership.

Sheryl has performed in community orchestras and bands throughout her career, and in 2012-2013 had the opportunity to perform with the Harmonie Municipale Aix en Provence in Southern France. Ms. Bowhay is active as an adjudicator, guest conductor and clinician.

Josephine van Lier - Strings



A versatile musician, Josephine van Lier is equally at ease either on a baroque cello, or a 5 string violoncello piccolo, or their contemporary counterparts. She uses instruments and bows whose designs, construction and material span over 400 years in origin, from the gut strings of her baroque cello to her 1870 cello, and to the space-age material of her carbon-fibre cello. She therefore covers a wide variety of repertoire utilizing the endless possibilities that this range of instruments, string set-ups, and bows allow her.
