Dear Ones,

As school begins again for a new year, the church gears up for a new year too. The liturgical year begins with Advent, but the school year begins a new program year each fall in the church. While we don't have any special events planned for September, we will begin a new season of Adult Education.

Adult Ed. Will begin on Sunday September 8th with a six-week series called "The Prodigal God." Prodigal means: 1) recklessly extravagant, 2) having spent everything. In this series the class will explore the parable looking at it in some different ways to discover the rich fullness of Jesus' brilliance in spinning this story on the spot. TREASURER'S REPORT – JUNE AND JULY 2019

Income for the months of June and July was \$16,693.20 (budget \$18,700.34). Expenditures totaled \$18,636.01 (budget \$18,700.34), resulting in a deficit for the two months of \$1,942.81.

There was one obligation due and unpaid at the end of July in the amount of \$303.50 which was paid in August.

Contributions to our Raise the Roof Fund during the months of June and July totaled \$46,558.06. Total raised as of July 31 - \$86,024.79.
