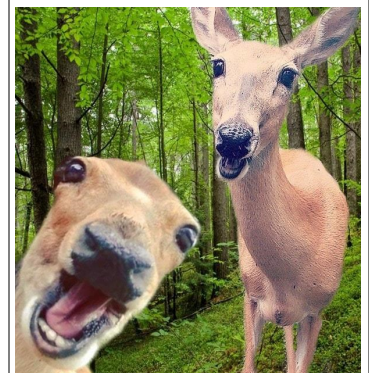

# LEGISLATION PENDING

The effect of the midterm elections on gun rights is likely to increase pressure for gun control. Incoming Democrat House members have repeatedly called for, what they term, common sense gun control. These measures include a general ban on all private ownership of firearms without strict screening and licensing provisions.

These proposals are unlikely to ever become law, at least under our current president, but it does give us a strong warning as to democrat intentions. As I see it, the coming year will feature two controversial pieces of legislation.

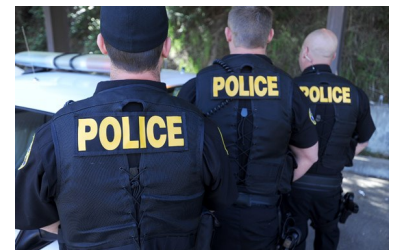
**Bump Stocks:** The president has faced opposition from the NRA and other gun rights groups for his support of a ban on Bump stocks. These devices are currently legal accessories, and use the rifles recoil to load and fire rounds faster than a standard semi-automatic; in that the trigger is pressed automatically, as the gun requires a pull of the trigger to operate each shot. It is still not a fully automatic weapon, but is a close enough to simulate a machine gun. A gun fitted with such a device can be effective in laying down a high rate of fire as we saw in Las Vegas. It makes the gun far less accurate than its semi auto counterpart. This legislation will almost certainly pass, as it has bi partisan support, though for different reasons. Personally, I do not see this as an infringement any more than age limits, and possessions by criminals are. In any case, this is a change in the law that is coming.

**Constitutional Carry:** This is another piece of legislation that is likely to be re-introduced in the Kentucky State Legislature. As it has been in previous years, its future is far less certain. The idea is that the Second Amendment does not make any restrictions on bearing arms, and therefore, all citizens should be allowed to carry a firearm without training or knowledge of any state laws. I have friends who ardently support this view. Harmony Hollow instructors do not, despite the fake accusations that we have a vested interest in maintaining a training component. The real reason is very simple; the laws on the use of deadly force, and carrying firearms in public, vary wildly from state to state. Ignorance of these laws is no defense in law or the court; therefore, the CCDW course is a protection for the gun owner far more than a restriction on gun ownership.

**Reciprocity Permits:** There has been a lot misinformation about reciprocity, and we have addressed this before. In some ways it is tied to the Constitutional carry argument. In effect, this proposal will force all states to recognize each other's permit, enabling a CCW holder from one state to carry concealed in all others. Broadly, this is a law we can all get behind. However, previous attempts have failed to make it through congress. Primarily because those States with onerous and

over burdensome CCW regulations, such as California, and New York, were not prepared to modify them to fall in line with the rest of the states. Equally, those states with standard training like Kentucky, Ohio, Tennessee, etc., were not prepared to burden their gun owners with petty regulations designed to dissuade gun owners from applying. Also, there is a fundamental misunderstanding, for some reason, on the reciprocity regulation. You have to physically have a permit in your possession to reciprocate with any other states permit. Therefore, if you come from a so called constitutional carry state and do not have a permit, you are not allowed to carry in any other state that does. For this reason all constitutional carry states run CCW courses.
