145th Church Anniversary

Just after the Christmas holidays, 145 years ago, a notable event occurred near the current intersection of US Highway 61 and County Road 31 where the Swede Schoolhouse was located. It was a temporary meeting place where Swedish pioneer families gathered



together. The pioneers had brought from their homeland a rich spiritual heritage. Sharing the same ancestral background, language and culture, they now expressed their fervent wish to also share their living faith in God. At the organization meeting on December 27, 1873, fifty-four people gave their unanimous consent in starting a Lutheran congregation. A list of Charter Members can be found in Dahlen Hall's display case.

The pastoral leadership for this significant event was the Rev. Eric Norelius who had established a church in Red wing in 1855 and the Cannon River church in 1857. Minnesota became the 32nd state in 1858

the same year the Spring Garden church started. A Cannon Falls church was established a year later, and the Prairie Island church began in 1870.

The charter members adopted several motions; one was to ask Pastor Anderson from Vasa to serve this congregation every other Sunday afternoon, for a stipend of \$100.00 per year plus transportation.

Church records show that in 1879 Pastor A. Palmstrom preaching was shared with a Hastings church for the next three years. Historically we've always been a two or three point parish. In February of 1924 at a special meeting it was decided to conduct one half of the service in Swedish and the other half in English. Over the years our church membership has become more diversified – anyone can join our church.
