From the Pastor's Desk

Dear brothers and sisters,

We are already on third Sunday of Lent. There are two main points that the Gospel speaks about are "grumbling" and "thirst". Let us speak about "grumbling" because it is more common than we think. The people of Israel has just gotten out of Egypt and God now brings them through the desert but not through the path that they think He should take. So, they start grumbling because they are thirsty, no way God can provide anything in the desert. It is this "grumbling" that is dangerous because it brings us to be fighting God for what we think is the "right" thing to happen. It goes opposite to what we pray in the Our Father – Thy will be done. It brings us to sadness and slowly to bitterness. And, the people grumbled because they were "thirsty" – lacking water (as symbol of life and the Spirit). We are looking for this life but when we look in the wrong place we are never satisfied as the Gospel points out with the Samaritan Woman. Only one has streams of living water that satisfy the deeps desires of our heart. So, let us ask Christ for that water and life in this Lenten Season.

As I announced last weekend, the Cardinal has asked us to take some preventive measures to avoid the spread of Coronavirus – thus, we have removed offering the chalice during mass for a time. I invite you not to fall into the pandemic of fear but to take precautions like washing your hands and if you are sick stay home, you are not committing a sin but is an act of charity.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas:

Ya estamos en el tercer domingo de Cuaresma. Hay dos puntos principales de los que habla el Evangelio: "murmuración" y "sed". Hablemos de "murmuración" porque es más común de lo que pensamos. El pueblo de Israel acaba de salir de Egipto y Dios ahora los lleva por el desierto, pero no por el camino que creen que debería tomar. Entonces, comienzan a quejarse porque tienen sed, de ninguna manera Dios puede proporcionar nada en el desierto. Es esta "murmuración" lo que es peligroso porque nos lleva a estar luchando contra Dios por lo que creemos que es lo "correcto". Va en contra de lo que oramos en el Padre Nuestro: Hágase tu voluntad. Nos lleva a la tristeza y lentamente a la amargura. Y, la gente se quejó porque tenía "sed" - falta de agua (como símbolo de la vida y el Espíritu). Estamos buscando esta vida, pero cuando miramos en el lugar equivocado, nunca estamos satisfechos como el Evangelio señala con la mujer samaritana. Solo uno tiene corrientes de agua viva que satisfacen los deseos más profundos de nuestro corazón. Entonces, pidamos a Cristo por esa agua y vida en esta temporada de Cuaresma.

Como anuncié el fin de semana pasado, el Cardenal nos ha pedido que tomemos algunas medidas preventivas para evitar la propagación del Coronavirus, por lo que hemos eliminado la oferta del cáliz durante la misa por un tiempo. Te invito a que no caigas en la pandemia del miedo, sino a tomar precauciones como lavarte las manos y, si estás enfermo, quédate en casa, no estás cometiendo un pecado, sino un acto de caridad.

Caros irmãos e irmãs

Já estamos no terceiro domingo da Quaresma. Há dois pontos principais sobre os quais o Evangelho fala: "resmungar" e "sede". Vamos falar de "resmungar" porque é mais comum do que pensamos. O povo de Israel acabou de sair do Egito e Deus agora os leva pelo deserto, mas não pelo caminho que eles pensam que Ele deveria seguir. Então, eles começam a resmungar porque estão com sede, de jeito nenhum Deus pode fornecer algo no deserto. É esse "resmungo" que é perigoso, porque nos leva a lutar contra Deus pelo que pensamos ser a coisa "certa". Isso vai oposto ao que oramos no Pai Nossa - seja feita a tua vontade. Isso nos leva à tristeza e lentamente à amargura. E as pessoas resmungavam porque estavam com "sede" - sem água (como símbolo da vida e do Espírito). Estamos procurando esta vida, mas quando olhamos para o lugar errado, nunca ficamos satisfeitos, como o Evangelho aponta com a mulher samaritana. Somente um tem correntes de água viva que satisfazem os desejos mais profundos do nosso coração. Então, peçamos a Cristo a água e a vida nesta estação quaresmal.

Como anunciei no fim de semana passado, o Cardeal nos pediu para tomar algumas medidas preventivas para evitar a disseminação do Coronavírus - assim, removemos a oferta do cálice durante a missa por um tempo. Convido você a não cair na pandemia do medo, mas a tomar precauções como lavar as mãos e, se estiver doente, ficar em casa, não estará cometendo pecado, mas é um ato de caridade.



Cardinal Tobin has directed the following:

Priests, deacons and extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion are urged to practice good hygiene, washing their hands before Mass begins or even using an alcohol based anti-bacterial solution before and after distributing Holy Communion, as is practiced in so many of our parishes and institutions already.

Assure the faithful that if they are sick or are experiencing symptoms of sickness they are not obligated to attend Mass, and even out of charity they ought not to attend.

The sign of peace should be exchanged without physical contact. Distribution of Holy Communion to the faithful via the chalice is to be suspended.

Cardenal Tobin ha dirigido lo siguiente:

Garanta aos fiéis que, se estiverem doentes ou apresentarem sintomas de doença, não serão obrigados a comparecer à missa e, mesmo por caridade, não deverão comparecer.

O sinal de paz deve ser trocado sem contato físico.

A distribuição da Sagrada Comunhão aos fiéis através do cálice deve ser suspensa.
