Camera equipment

I use higher-grade cameras and lighting equipment why I typically charge higher rates to help cover their overhead for equipment and insurance. In general, better equipment also results in a higher-quality photo outcome, which is worth the extra cost. Lenses and other equipment are also very expensive. It's critical that sports photographers have the right gear to capture the action, however. Fast action games and other sports require a camera capable of high frame-per-second (fps) shooting.
