
Jesus is DESPISED! Are YOU despised?

esus had no place to lay his head, remember? Isaiah the prophet wrote about Jesus: "He IS DE-SPISED and REJECTED OF MEN; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we HID as it were our faces from him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not" (ISAIAH 53:3).

The word "<u>DESPISE</u>" means <u>to look down upon with contempt and scorn</u>. If you are a <u>true follower</u> of Jesus Christ, then you should be <u>DESPISED</u> of men too.

Jesus said to his disciples, "Verily, verily, I say unto you, The servant is not <u>greater</u> than his Lord; neither he that is <u>SENT</u> (WHICH ARE HIS FOLLOWERS) greater than <u>he that sent him</u> (AND THAT'S JESUS)" (JOHN 13:16).

Are <u>YOU</u> a partaker of "...the <u>FELLOWSHIP</u> of his <u>sufferings</u>" (PHILIP. 3:10) or have you taken the "<u>easy</u>" and "<u>comfortable</u>" road of "<u>compromise</u>," gaining friendships and admirations with the world?

Jesus also said to his disciples, "If the world <u>HATE</u> you, ye know that it <u>HATED me BEFORE</u> it <u>HATED you..."</u> (JOHN 15:18-19), and <u>ALL</u> believers "...that will live godly <u>in Christ Jesus</u> shall <u>SUFFER persecution</u>" (2 TIM. 3:12).

Jesus said, "Blessed are ye, when men shall <u>HATE</u> you, and when they shall <u>SEPARATE</u> <u>YOU</u> from their company, and shall <u>reproach</u> you, and <u>cast</u> <u>out your name as evil</u>, for the Son of man's sake" (LUKE 6:22).

Has the world "<u>SEPARATED</u>" from you? If not, get on your knees now and repent. You have a <u>counterfeit</u>.



Jesus was <u>never</u> "well-liked" as these ministers. Jesus was <u>never</u> "respected" and "revered" by the world as these. But, "...the <u>foundation of God</u> standeth <u>SURE</u>, having this seal, <u>The Lord knoweth them that are his"</u> (2 Tim. 2:19).

Of all the <u>EVIL</u> that is done under the sun, there is none greater than a <u>FALSE REPRESENTATIVE</u> of <u>the Word of God</u> that will make <u>MERCHANDISE</u> out of the souls of men and women.

Peter said "...there shall be <u>false teachers</u> among you, who [PRIVATELY] shall bring in <u>damnable</u> heresies, even <u>denying the Lord</u> that bought them...and <u>MANY</u> shall follow their <u>pernicious</u> [RUIN; LOSS] ways; by reason of whom <u>the way of truth shall be evil spoken of</u>. And through <u>covetousness</u> [GREEDINESS] shall they with <u>feigned</u> [ARTIFICIAL; PRETENSE] <u>words make merchandise</u> of <u>you</u>" (2 PETER 2:1-3).

If the world is <u>FRIENDLY</u> towards you, it's because you are still <u>of</u> the world. Therefore, as Jesus said, "The world <u>cannot hate you</u>; <u>but me it hateth</u>, <u>BECAUSE I testify of it, that the works thereof</u> <u>are evil</u>" (JOHN 7:7).

"WHOSOEVER therefore shall be ashamed of me and of MY WORDS in this ADULTEROUS and SINFUL generation; of him also shall the Son of man be ashamed, WHEN HE COMETH in the glory of his Father with the holy angels" (MARK 8:38).
