### January Update

#### Canada Exchange: Verna Bunn, Exchange Coordinator

Our Canadian Exchange includes 2 weeks of home hosting: The first week will be in Lehtbridge from May 30, 2018 to June 5, and

second week in Saskatoon from June 5 to June 11. The cost of the exchange will be between \$800.00 and \$1000.00 plus air fare and travel insurance for the first 2 weeks

The quote from First Class Travel for the first two weeks is \$1042.00. To add the airfare from Vancouver using the train is \$1171.94. You would have the \$245.70 train fare and don't forget the travel insurance. So the total of the exchange should be under \$2000.00 for the first two weeks.

I don't have activity information from Lehtbridge as yet as their meeting isn't until January. In Saskatoon



we will be touring their University, Canadian Light Source Syncatron, Lunch at Waneskewin World Heritage site, a demonstration of indigenous dances and a teepee set up, Western Development Museum Curatorial Center, Bessborough Hotel and there are some optional activities. Some of which are a River cruise, Remai Modern Art Gallery, Ukrainian Museum, Berry Barn or Diefenbaker Center. It sounds like some great things to see and do.

I will be looking into leaving Saskatoon on the train to Vancouver and visit Victoria Island which will be on your own but I haven't done much on that as yet. I just know the train trip would take 1 day and 12 hours and cost about \$245.70, I would be looking at returning on June 17<sup>th</sup>. This would be an add on after the exchange.

I would like to have the application and the \$200.00 nonrefundable deposit by January 18<sup>th</sup>. This is the date of our next meeting. If we don't have 16 from our club, I will then send it out to other clubs in our region. I hope many of you will join us in the exchange, I think we will have a lot of fun.
