

In July of 2013, Terri Bocklund and her husband Curt Kowalski had the musical adventure of a lifetime. Chosen by jury to be an Artist-in-Residence at Isle Royale National Park, her new CD is a collection inspired by the greatest of the Great Lakes and the spirit of place that is Isle Royale: an unspoiled northwoods wilderness archipelago inhabited by the wolf and the moose, the gray jay and the raven, the lady slipper orchid and the balsam fir.

The music is organic, guitar-driven, and it is sublime. With strings and fingers and a voice "like warm honey," Terri paints a musical image of fog and wind, loons and wrens, rambling trails, and the northern lights. She sings about the open hand of this special place, and the gifts of smooth stones and rocky shorelines, silver birch trees, the music of the water, and the ancient story told in rock itself. The music shimmers with touches of wood flute, hand percussion, warm vocal harmonies, Native American lore and song, and natural sounds Terri recorded during her Residency. A poem by Gary Lawless (a 1997 Isle Royale Artist in Residence), serves as the foundation for a piece that brings the entire project together, called *The Open Hand of Lake and Isle*.
