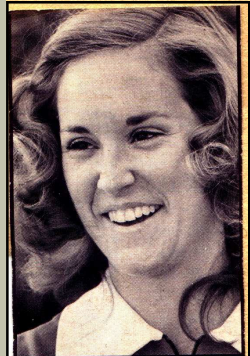
B. SHEPHERD: "I don't think there is any 'life after death' because you don't really die — your body dies, but your soul lives on."

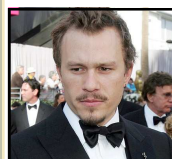
ens with God, or to hell fire. Our spirit cannot die (MARK 9:44, 46, 48).

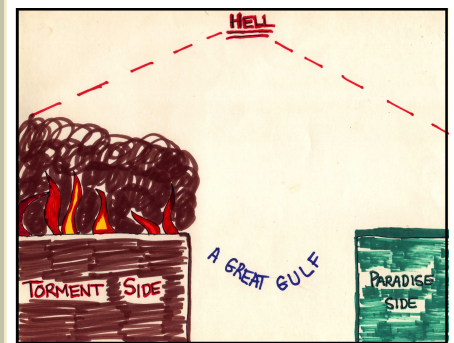

Beware: There are many religious people who believe that these verses are a parable, but our Lord Jesus said the words "**THERE WAS.**" If there was not a "certain rich man" or a "beggar named Lazarus," then Jesus lied. But we know he didn't: "...let God be true, but every man a liar" (ROMANS 3:4).

"And it came to pass, that the beggar **DIED, and was carried by the angels into Abraham's bosom** [OR PLACE OF COMFORT]: the rich man also **DIED, and was buried; and IN HELL HE LIFT UP**

HIS EYES, being in torments, and seeth Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom" (LUKE 16:22-23).

Yes, the spirit of man still has eyes, and he can see with them, and he can feel pain in Hell. If you don't believe in a hell, there are only two ways to know for sure: believe the Word of God now...or go there yourself when you die.



The Old Testament Paradise in Hell

Before the crucifixion of Jesus, all who died went to the center of this earth (hell) which was divided into two parts: the torment side and the paradise side.

After Jesus was crucified, he descended into "...the heart of the earth" (MATTHEW 12:40) for three days, and "...preached unto the spirits in prison" (1 PETER 3:19). He then "...led captivity captive" (EPHES. 4:8) into the heavens above, "...the paradise of God" (REV. 2:7). But now, hell's mouth is wide open (ISA. 5:14).

The rich man, who enjoyed his life while others suffered around him, said, "...**Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus, that he may dip the tip of his finger in water, and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame**" (LUKE 16:24).

Yes, Abraham was there too, so it was not a parable.

The selfish nature of the rich man had not changed in hell. In his arrogance, he requested the beggar Lazarus to attend to his needs first. But Abraham explained that was impossible because there was a great gulf FIXED between them.

Abraham also said to the rich man, "...**Son, REMEMBER that thou IN THY LIFETIME receivedst thy good things, and likewise Lazarus evil things: but now HE IS COMFORTED, and thou art tormented**" (LUKE 16:25).

Every unbelieving soul that has died, or will die, will **RE-MEMBER** the life they once lived in hell to their regret. They will also **REMEMBER** their loved ones, and fear that they too, will follow them into hell.

The rich man made a second request to send the beggar Lazarus, "...**I pray thee therefore, father, that thou wouldst send him to my father's house: for I have FIVE BRETHREN; that he may TESTIFY unto them, LEST they also come into this PLACE OF TORMENT**" (LUKE 16:27-28).

The rich man thought that if Lazarus could come back from the grave and bring proof to his brothers of LIFE after DEATH, they would escape hell. But Abraham said,

"...**They have Moses and the prophets; let them hear them**" (LUKE 16:29). In other words, they had the Old Testament scriptures to convince them. Today, we have both the Old and New Testament, "...**the perfect [COMPLETE] law of liberty**" (JAMES 1:25).

The rich man replied with exasperation, "...**Nay, father Abraham: but if one went unto them from the dead, THEY WILL REPENT. And he said unto him, If they HEAR NOT Moses and the prophets, neither will they be PERSUADED, though one rose from the dead**" (LUKE 16:30-31).

Before you can be saved, before accepting Jesus Christ as your Saviour, before repentance before God, you must, **YOU ABSOLUTELY MUST** be persuaded and convinced by the Word of God that **YOU** are sinful and on the road to Hell.
