Notes from the VP Jeff Day - Vice-President

WHAT IS MAGIC ?

A sunrise? A baby cry? Music? I'm sure it's all relative. What is magical to me is probably not as magical to you. I do know, however, that magic is not just in the eye or ear of the beholder. Magic does exist in this world. Whether you believe or not, MAGIC will always turn a pessimist into an optimist, even if it's only for a few minutes. For us magicians, it's that "something" that inspires us to pursue a goal of a successful performance, and to relay the impossible to an audience, that was a moment before skeptical, but now an audience of believers.

Archie Frederick Collins was an inventor and avid experimenter in the late 19th century. He actually was one of the patent holders of the inductions wireless telephone. Yes, that's right .. wireless telephone! This was back in 1898 when Collins started researching the idea. It was not until 1909 when the patent was issued. I am bold to say that Collins created something magical. There were several reasons that it didn't catch on, but he went on to invent something else that DID have a purpose at that time. It was a device to transmit Morse code without the use of wires. It was something more practical for that time, but Collins was way ahead of his time.

Collins was a prolific author, writing such books as, "The Boys & Girls Books of Outdoor Games", "The Amateur Chemist", "The Boy Scientist", & "The Book of Magic". Collins was an interesting man who often times pushed the boundaries, which ultimately landed him in prison for one year due to mail fraud. He wasn't perfect by any means, but he was persistently trying to do something useful. The trick, I think, is to be persistent, but I suppose you need to stay within the lines.

The following excerpt is from "The Book of Magic", and it says a great deal to all magicians.



"The Book of Magic" Being A Simple Description of Some Good Tricks and How To Do Them, With Patter'

D. Appleton & Company New York - London 1919

"The tricks in this book are the kind which are used at the present time by professional magicians – indeed many of them were the stock and trade of a well-known conjurer who did them nightly for a period of ten years before brilliant assemblages and his wide experience has been written into this book.

One more word. Of course, practice tends to make perfect, and if you will practice any trick on sleight for thirty minutes every day for a month you will be surprised to find how well you will be able to do it. But there is no need for me to tell you to practice, for if you like magic and it likes you it will not be long before you can give a show which will, as Keller used to say, baffle the senses, astound the mind, and mystify the human brain."
