•	To maintain the ability to economically provide adequate public services such as roads, fire protection, and other public needs
*	To ensure a desired future pattern of development, especially on lands that front on water
*	To prevent additional waterfront subdivision development in the absence of minimum standards and guidelines to adequately protect lakes and waterways from potential surface and groundwater degradation and other community interests, and

WHEREAS, It is in is in the best interest of the Town of <u>FARMINGTON</u> that new waterfront subdivisions and existing waterfront variances be consistent with the "Graphic Vision", the comprehensive Land/Stormwater Management Plan and implementation for the Waupaca area which is expected to be completed in the next 12 months.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Town of FARMINGTON requests Waupaca County to declare a moratorium on any and all future waterfront subdivisions for a period of 12 months or until such time the comprehensive Waupaca Area Land/Stormwater Management Plan and implementation is complete (whichever is less) in the Town of FARMINGTON, and
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Town of FARMINGTON also requests Waupaca
County's Board of Adjustment declare a moratorium on any and all variance requests of
waterfront development in the Town of FARMINGTON for that same period of time, and
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Town of FARMINGTON requests the starting date for the moratorium commence upon the adoption of such a resolution/ordinance by the Waupaca County Board of Supervisors.
