## "...they ALL slumbered and slept..." Day Star Publications July 24, 2009

f your eyes have been opened, as one brought out of darkness, and you are looking for Christ to return, then these words should mean something to you: "...knowing the time, that NOW it is high time to AWAKE out of sleep: for NOW is our salvation NEARER than when we believed" (ROMANS 13:11). Have you believed? Consider the story of the TEN virgins.

In Matthew 25: 1-13, Jesus said that the kingdom of heaven is compared to <u>ten virgins</u>. They are called "virgins" because they <u>ALL</u> profess to be espoused to **ONE** husband, Jesus, our Savior.



They all took "their" lamps, which represent the Word of God: "Thy <u>WORD</u> is a <u>lamp</u> unto my feet, and a <u>light</u> unto my path" (PSALM 119:105). They <u>ALL</u> went forth to meet the bridegroom, which is Christ.

Out of these <u>ten virgins</u>, <u>five</u> were wise and <u>five</u> were foolish, which demonstrates both the believer and unbeliever, the "<u>wheat and the tares</u>," growing "<u>together until the harvest</u>" (MATTHEW 13:30).

Throughout the scriptures, the descriptions of the "<u>true</u>" and the "<u>false</u>" are clearly seen: the <u>Wheat</u> and the <u>Tares</u>; <u>children of the Kingdom</u> and the <u>children of the Wicked One</u>; <u>light</u> and <u>darkness</u>; <u>brethren</u> and <u>false brethren</u>; <u>sheep</u> and <u>goats</u>.

The difference between the wise and foolish virgins is, the <u>wise</u> took oil in their "<u>vessels</u>" with their lamps, while "...they that were foolish took their lamps, and <u>took</u> no oil with them" (vs. 3). The "<u>Oil</u>" is an Old Testa-

ment symbol of the Holy Spirit, and the "<u>vessels</u>" mentioned is a type of the body of the believer where the Holy Spirit (OIL) dwells.

"While the bridegroom tarried, they all slumbered and slept. And at MIDNIGHT there was a cry made, Behold, the bridegroom cometh; go ye out to meet him" (vs. 5-6). We are living in the MIDNIGHT hour now, when Christ will come for his Bride.

"Then <u>ALL</u> those virgins arose, and trimmed their lamps. And the foolish said unto the wise, Give us of your oil; for our lamps are <u>gone out</u>. But the wise answered, saying, Not so; lest there be not enough for us and you: but <u>go ye</u> rather to them that sell, and <u>BUY</u> for yourselves" (vs 7-10).



In the Word of God, it is written: "Buy the TRUTH, and sell it not; also wisdom, and instruction, and understanding" (PROVERBS 23:23). These items come with a price: YOUR SUBMISSION!

"...but <u>NOW</u> [GoD] commandeth <u>all men</u> every where to <u>REPENT</u>: <u>Because</u> he hath appointed <u>a day</u>, in the which he will <u>judge</u> the world in righteousness by that man [JESUS] whom he hath ordained..." (ACTS 17:30-31).

"And while they went to buy, the bridegroom came; and they that were READY went in with him to the marriage: and the door was SHUT" (vs. 10). All believers will soon meet the Lord in the air, and the

door of opportunity will be <u>SHUT</u> to those who have heard the Word, and rejected it. Those members of the "<u>lukewarm</u>" visible church (REVELATION 3:16), which desire sermons of "<u>smooth things</u>" (ISAIAH 30:10) will not "<u>endure sound doctrine</u>," (2 TIMOTHY 4:3), and will be **LEFT BEHIND**.



"...God shall send them <u>STRONG DELU-SION</u>, that they should <u>BELIEVE A LIE</u>: That they <u>ALL</u> might be damned who <u>believed not the TRUTH</u>, but had pleasure in unrighteousness" (2 THES. 2:11-12).



"Afterward came also the other virgins, saying, LORD, LORD, open to us. But he answered and said, Verily I say unto you, I KNOW YOU NOT. Watch therefore, for ye know neither the day nor the hour wherein the Son of man cometh" (vs 11-13).

Are <u>YOU</u> watching? Do you possess "<u>OIL</u>" with your lamp? "<u>Examine yourselves</u>, whether ye be <u>IN the faith</u>; <u>PROVE</u> your own selves. <u>Know ye not</u> your own selves, how that <u>Jesus Christ is IN you</u>, except

ye be <u>reprobates</u>" (2 COR. 13:15)? Jesus told his disciples "...I will pray the Father, and <u>he shall give</u> you <u>ANOTHER Comforter</u>, that he may <u>abide</u> with you for ever; Even the <u>Spirit of truth</u>...for he dwelleth with you, and <u>shall be IN you</u>" (JOHN 14:16-17).

The Holy Spirit  $\underline{\textbf{IS}}$  the believer's " $\underline{\textit{Oil}}$ " and " $\underline{\textit{Comforter}}$ " today, and He dwells  $\underline{\textbf{IN}}$  every believer. But the religious world  $\underline{\textit{WILL NOT}}$  believe it.

Even when it is <u>WRITTEN</u> in the scriptures: "But the anointing [THE HOLY SPIRIT] which ye <u>have received of him</u> abideth <u>IN you</u>, and ye need not that <u>any man teach you</u>: but as the same anointing <u>teacheth you of ALL things</u>, and is <u>TRUTH</u>, and <u>is no lie</u>, and even as it hath taught you, ye

shall abide in him" (1
JOHN 2:27), the <u>religious</u>
<u>masses</u> <u>will not be-</u>
lieve it.

Instead, they "heap to themselves" a "man" or a "translation" to understand the Word of God, rather than allow God Himself to teach them by faith.



While the world continues to worship all the "Rev. Wonderfuls," the <u>true</u> invisible church will be ushered <u>out</u> of this world through the <u>DOOR</u>, in the air.



"STRIVE to enter in at the strait gate: for many, I say unto you, will seek to enter in, and shall not be able" (LUKE 13:24). WHY? "Because strait is the gate, and NARROW is the way, which leadeth unto life, and FEW there be that find it" (MATTHEW 7:14).

"AWAKE to righteousness, and SIN NOT; for some have not the knowledge of God" (1 Cor. 15:34).
