We have been busy as usual in the Joey's room. We are continuing to support the children's toilet training efforts with several of our friends moving into undies while others have started sitting on the toilet. Putting our shoes and socks on has also been a big push for the older children and just this week we have started to offer the older children the opportunity to attempt to manage their own lunchboxes, i.e. choosing their sandwiches first etc.
