Bravo Course Signals

This information is provided in accordance with section 2.1 and 3.1 of the Sailing Instructions.

Section B2 is deleted and replaced by the following:

B2. COURSES

B2.1. The course will be a windward-leeward configuration as shown below. A signal corresponding to the configuration will be displayed on a staff.

B2.2. All races will be 2 loops.

B2.3. For Course SA, the race committee will display the course bearing and length of the windward leg using display boards.

B2.3-B2.4. For Course SB, the race committee will display, on a staff, the number of the fixed mark on Alpha Course that will be used as Mark 1, and the course bearing and length of the windward leg using display boards.

B2.4-B2.5. For Course FA, the race committee will display, on a staff, the number of the fixed mark on Alpha Course that will be used as Mark 1.

B2.5-B2.6. The length of the windward leg will be set such that the lead boat will finish in approximately 30 minutes.

B2.6-B2.7. Two races will be run each night at the discretion of the Race Committee.
