## Tree Removal Permit Application

**Exceptions**: If the tree removal is part of an existing grading permit, building permit or site design plan review then you do *not* need to submit this form. If the tree is located within 100 feet of the water then a <u>Critical Area Buffer Management</u> <u>Plan</u> may be required. Please submit appropriate <u>forms</u> to the Department of Planning and Zoning.

## Reason for Removal of Tree(s)

The tree or large section of the tree, 50% or more, is dead, dying, or in danger of falling

The tree is diseased, insect infested, or injured and cannot reasonably be restored

The tree constitutes a hazard to the safety of persons or threatens injury to property, including other trees

Removal of the tree is consistent with good forestry practices. ie: invasive or weak-wooded species

Removal of the tree will avoid, mitigate or reduce substantial damage to the property. ie: structures, sidewalks, etc.

## **Requirements for Replacement Trees**

- Must be a native species and a minimum size of 1.5" caliper (diameter measured 6" from ground)
- For a listing of acceptable native tree species, please review the plant guide, also linked on our webpage.

Please note that failure to plant replacement trees within 1 year of permit issuance shall be considered a MUNICIPAL INFRACTION and may be punishable by fine.

Proof of planting within 1 year of permit issuance shall be required to close out the permit. Acceptable forms of proof include photos and/or a copy of the receipt from a nursery showing number, size and species of trees purchased. Please email proof to the City Urban Forester or call 410-260-2200 ext 7718 if unable to send by email.

If you are unable to plant replacement trees, a fee-in-lieu of planting may be accepted at \$350.00 per tree required for replacement. If accepted, these funds will be used by the City of Annapolis to plant and maintain trees in public places.

Include a drawing in the space below showing approximate location of building, sidewalk, street or alley and the location of the tree(s) to be removed and planned location for replacement tree(s).

The applicant certifies and agrees as follows: (1) that they are authorized to make this application; (2) that the information is correct; (3) that they will comply with all regulations of the City of Annapolis which are applicable hereto; (4) that they will only perform work on the above property specifically described in this application: (5) that they grant City officials the right to enter onto the property for the purpose of inspecting the work permitted and posting notices; (6) if you choose to appeal the issuance, decision, determination or order of this permit, the petition for appeal shall be in writing stating the grounds for appeal and shall be filed with the Office of Environmental Policy within 15 calendar days of issuance. decision, determination or order. Any right to appeal shall be waived if not timely filed.

No machinery or work shall start prior to 7:00 AM and shall finish no later than dusk and there shall be no work performed on Sunday unless otherwise authorized.
