

## MEETING REPORT

Council of the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32 held their regular meeting of Council on Thursday, May 11<sup>th</sup>, 2017 in the Municipal Office in the Rural Municipality of Reciprocity No. 32, Saskatchewan with one councillor absent.

The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. with Reeve Arthur presiding.

Minutes of the Regular Meeting held on April 13<sup>th</sup>, 2017 were approved as circulated, the Statements of Financial Activities for the month of April were accepted as presented and the accounts were passed and approved for payment.

Representatives of the Glen Ewen Trailblazers Light Horse 4-H club attended the meeting to discuss various activities they performed in 2016 and explained various projects that they would be involved with, in 2017. Council acknowledged receipt of a road ban, road open notices, and road closed notices. Council authorized a contribution to the Shock Trauma Air Rescue Society (STARS) and reinstated Donna Fraser as a Seasonal Public Works Employee. Council authorized the signing of two water well lease agreements and authorized a road improvement project.

Public Works Foreman, Andy Girard, attended the meeting to discuss various matters pertaining to the workshop operation.

A road right-of way application was approved by council for a utility dig.

Correspondence was received and filed.
