The purpose of The Hunter's Run Conservancy District is to maintain the 9 primary flood retarding dams and 20 sediment and erosion control dams within the Hunter's Run and Upper Hocking River Watershed. The twenty-nine structures currently maintained were completed between 1958 and 1960. The watershed encompasses approximately 49 square miles including the West Side of the City of Lancaster and surrounding area with a boundary beginning near the Broad St/Hocking River bridge on Memorial Drive, extending west to US 22 and Delmont Rd., then northwest to the intersection of Marcy Rd. and Betz Rd., then northeast to the intersection of Carroll Eastern Rd. and SR 158, then following SR 158 south into Lancaster and returning to the Broad St. Bridge.

The District management staff of three Directors and Secretary/Treasurer meet monthly on the above schedule.
