**Present:** Chair Sedey, Treasurer Harkman, Secretary Peterson, Directors Miller, Bergstrom, Boie, Kelso

**Not present:** Directors Honsey, Mader

**Treasurer Report:** Current balance of \$23K, Recent bills paid: Insurance \$1K, Lake Restoration Treatment \$3K, Lake Sylvia Pilot Study \$5K, Picnic \$400. Donations of \$1K & \$100 received.

**Membership:** 94 total members this year. At present the membership applications go through 3 parties before the process is complete. Next year this will be reduced to one.

**DNR:** Chair Sedey shared with group a letter from Ty Riihiluoma, NR Technician with the Ecological and Water Resources Dept. findings from a recent lake sampling the DNR completed on Pleasant Lake. Confirmation of findings will be shared with our association in the near future. The DNR grant we received this past year will be unavailable next year. Director Bergstrom will be in contact with Wenck and Lake Restoration relating to any DNR findings.

**Lake Sylvia Pilot Study:** Director Boie is the Pleasant Lake representative and Director Bergstrom is the alternate. The full Study Governing Board will consist of 11 members. The favorable comments received following the meeting on August 23<sup>rd</sup> in the Annandale park totaled over 500 while the negative responses totaled 70. The concern of all parties is the health of the three lakes participating in the study. Changes have been made to the study plan by the DNR and the Wright County Water and Soil. The new plan should be going before the County Commissioners on September 19<sup>th</sup> for their final decision.
