Part One: Its Priestly Aspect

Even before the fall in the Garden of Eden, God had already purposed in His heart to bring redemption to mankind. In fact, the Bible says that the Lamb of God was slain since BEFORE the world came to be. 1 Peter 1:20 says “He was chosen BEFORE the creation of the world, but was revealed in the last times for your sake.” And Revelation 13:8 says something similar “All the inhabitants of the earth will worship the beast, all whose names have not been written in the book of life belonging to the Lamb that was slain from the creation of the world.

Our Father is consistently interested in always providing help to those who show signs of vulnerability. So our Lord came on the scene of humanity to do something that the blood of bulls, lambs, goats couldn't do. He fulfilled His assignment and returned to heaven. But before He did so, He trained a handful of men and made them His replacement and told them of what they would accomplish through the power of His Name, the power of His blood, and the power of His Holy Spirit. Those men too left the scene and today, the divine assignment has been passed down to the Church at different levels. Some as

apostles, prophets, pastors, teachers, and as evangelists. Underneath, or surrounding all of that, you find the intercessors.

Today, we want to connect the office of the intercessor with two key people in the Bible whom our Lord is linked to in different ways. In this issue, we will look at “the **Priesthood**” Aspect of the office of Intercession.”

After Moses' death, God wanted to pick-up where Moses failed, which was to bring the Israelites across the Jordan and into the Promised Land. This was the physical aspect of that task. The man assigned to that task was Joshua, Israel's High Priest after Moses, the general of their armies, with a very toll order to bring deliverance to the children of Israel, conquer their enemies and give to each tribe their allotted inheritance. The Canaanites and the other nations had become illegal in those territories. The Rephaim, the Anakim were the descendants of the Nephilim (Gen 6:1-4, Num 13: 22-33, Jos 15:13-14), Enim, Zamzummin or Zuzim (Deut 2:20). Goliath was a Rephaim. Thus, the Amorites, Jebusites and all the other ..ites that lived in the land, most of them giants, were the descendants of

those fallen angels, making them half human. Joshua was appointed by God to rid the land of every last of them so Israel could receive their earthly inheritance. Joshua was in fact a deliverer, a type of Christ, the Messiah who was to come. In fact, his name also means Jesus, Joshua being the Greek version of the name. In Exo 23:20, the Lord says: “My angel shall bring thee into the place I have prepared.” He further says “My Name is in him.” According to the Matthew Henry Commentary, it means that Joshua's name should be the same with that of the Messiah, which means, he shall save; for he saved God's people from their enemies and Jesus saves us from our sins. Christ, as Joshua, is the captain of our salvation, a leader, a commander of the people; to tread satan under their feet, to put them in possession of the heavenly Canaan, and to give them rest, something Joshua couldn't do according to Heb 4:8.

Joshua's assignment was very clear and he was **fully** equipped to **successfully** do it. He had been in training for 40 years by his predecessors Moses and Aaron. He knew what worked and what didn't. He knew what God says was to be taken very seriously and he was very

In early January, right after New Year's I received a call from my daughter asking for prayer for her friend who had a massive stroke. She explained she was only thirty-six years old, seems fit as a military wife also a member of the military herself. The hospital didn't realize she was having a stroke because it didn't measure up to her previous health record. When they realized it was a stroke, it was too late to stop it. So she went into a full stroke and was unconscious, was put in intensive care and no one was sure if she would make it. A week went by no change. I emailed Pastor Mireille of ETIPM

Global and requested prayer for the young woman, (wife, mother, soldier). My daughter had mentioned that they were also a Christian family.

As the request went out, daily prayers went up for her by the intercessors of ETIPM Global. determined that nothing or no one would cause him to fail his assignment (Jos 24:15).

The following are some of Joshua's conquests and the demonstration of his God-given powers:

1. He parted the Jordan River
2. He conquered Jericho
3. He stopped the sun and moon in Gibeon to stay in the fight with daylight
4. He conquered Ai
5. He defeated Sihon, king of the Amorites
6. He defeated the five kings that joined forces against him
7. In Joshua 12:9-24, he defeated 31 kings, west of the Jordan
8. The conquered territories and people included: Amorites, Canaanites, Hittites, Jebusites, Perizzites, etc.

What made Joshua so successful, in addition to the training he received from his predecessors, was his faith in God's promises. He was also a humble servant who faithfully served Moses. Joshua also had an anointing from God Himself. In Jos 1:1-9 we see how God launched him into his calling, clothing him with great honor, assurances and encouragements. God also promised him to be with him just as He was with Moses, and that no one in his lifetime could stand to him. Furthermore, God **admonished** him to stay in the Word (v.8) "**This Book of the law shall not depart from your mouth, but thou shall meditate on it day and night, that you**

should obey everything written in it. Only then will you prosper and succeed in all you do." In 1 Cor 10:11, Paul says that whatever is seen in the Old Testament, they are examples for us today.

When one looks at Joshua's assignment, it is clear that his role was that of an intercessor. All those of previous and of Joshua's generations that knew war died in the desert, except Joshua and Caleb. Those that crossed the Jordan were 20 years and younger. They had not yet even been circumcised, they had not yet learned war and they had giants to face on the other side. They just couldn't do it on their own. Yes! They had to be part of what was taking place, but Joshua was the commander, a mighty general, leading the way.

As intercessors, God has, like Joshua — Yeshua, called us to a great task, to set captives free, to bring deliverance, to bring salvation, to put the strong man out of business, to restore what has been hijacked by satan. This too is also a tall order. But we have been anointed to take down wicked kings and their kingdoms, take back territories, take back lives, reset the course of destiny, activate purpose, shut down plots and plans, annihilate, obliterate, utterly destroy satan's fortresses, strongholds, citadels, etc. We are more powerful than we could ever imagine, because of the anointing that God has placed on us. If only we could see in the realm of the spirit what takes place when we pray, as we

heard Bishop Jean-Gerard Rhau express at our 10th anniversary banquet last August. As Jesus or Joshua was successful, we too **WILL BE** successful. The secret is in Joshua 1:9. Once we follow those instructions, there is no telling of what we will accomplish for the Lord. The professional athlete knows that to be successful, he needs to be disciplined. In addition to his rigorous training, he cannot eat whatever his heart desires. He needs his rest, he needs to stay focused on the goal and constantly follow the instructions of his coach.

Remember in Eze 22:30, God says: "**I looked for someone among them who would build up the wall and stand before Me in the gap on behalf of the land so I would not destroy it, but I found no one.**"

Is God still saying this today? He certainly is, but by His grace many have answered that call. Now, we must **PUSH** with all of our might to fulfill that call to the fullest. Let's be clear, there is nothing glamorous about it, because it requires self-denial, humility, temperance, consistency, discipline, tenacity, boldness, fearlessness, peace, joy, honesty, integrity, reverence for God and His Word. If you're looking to be acknowledged, be given credit or pat on the back down here, than you might be disappointed. Joshua's/ Jesus' agenda was different, so must ours be. So, suit up and let's fight until the end!

To God be all the glory for using pastor Mireille and anointing her in such a way for His service. I pray for more of God's favor upon ETIPM Global.

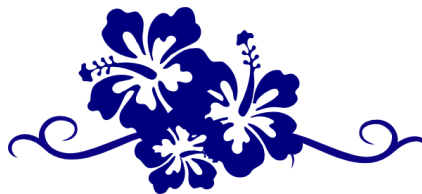

The Digestive System - *by Sister Fiona Watson*

It is a group of organs working together to convert food into the entire body. Food passes through a long tube inside of the body known as the Gastrointestinal Tract, (GI Tract).

The GI Tract is made up of the Oral Cavity, Pharynx, Esophagus, Stomach, Small Intestine and Large Intestine. Along with the GI Tract, there are several important Accessory Organs that help your body to digest food but NOT have food pass through them.

Accessory Organs consist of the Teeth, Tongue, Salivary Gland, Liver, Gall Bladder, the Pancreas.

There are six major functions that take place in the Digestive System to achieve the goal of providing energy and nutrients to the body.

- (1) Ingestion, (2) Secretion, (3) Mixing and Movement, (4) Digestion, (5) Absorption and (6) Excretion

Mouth: Digestion begins in the mouth Oral Cavity. Inside the mouth are many Accessory Organs that aid in the Digestion of food: the Teeth, Tongue and Salivary Glands.

The **Teeth** chop the food into small pieces, which are moistened by Saliva before the tongue and other muscles push the food into the pharynx.

The Teeth are the hardest substance of the body. They are living organs and contain blood vessels and nerves. The Teeth are designed for cutting and grinding food into smaller pieces.

If our teeth are not functioning properly, we will have problems with the food we are eating. We will not be able to chew and grind our food to the right consistency for swallowing. This could cause pain when eating, causing us to choke while eating thus harm our bod-

ies. It would thus be impossible for us to enjoy the meal presented to us.

As there is a process for the physical food, so is there a process for the spiritual food.

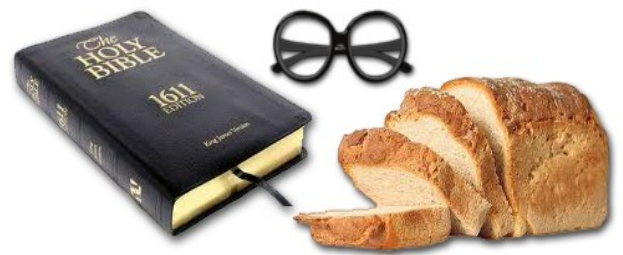
When we eat of the spiritual food, we need to take small bites and spend time to chew on the food, the Word. If we take big bites and don't chew properly, we can choke, as well as miss out on the pleasure in the (spiritual) meal. Our body would neither be properly nourished; that is, we would not gain the richness of the Word in our lives.
