ARRIVAL

Drop off will be from 8-9 am. There will be welcome activities planned for campers during drop off and program will start at 9 am. Please advise us, if your child will be absent or late.

A parent, guardian or a responsible adult must accompany ALL campers and sign them in and out each day.

All medications and canteen money should to be handed in at registration.

DEPARTURE

Pick up is at 4:00 each day. If early pick up is required, please let us know the morning of, so we can make sure your child is ready. Campers must be signed out prior to departure.

MEDICATION

Healthcare is taken very seriously for your child(ren) at the Ranch. Please advise us at registration if there are any changes to your child(ren)'s medical information. **The Ranch reserves the right to refuse admission to any Rancher with a suspected contagious condition (eg. Chickenpox or lice).** To ensure your child(ren) has an enjoyable week, and to protect other ranchers, please have any condition treated completely before coming to camp. If this is not possible, please call and reschedule to another week in our summer program, depending on availability. Due to the structure of our program, U-Turn Ranch requests that medications required throughout the year be sent with your child(ren) to camp.

Though U-turn Ranch works hard to care for and protect and individuals items, we do not assume responsibility for lost or damaged items. **Lost and found will be held till the following week.**

ALLERGIES

If a special diet was noted on the application, U-Turn Ranch staff will contact you prior to camp with a menu. We ask that any substitutions be brought with you on the Monday morning for the duration of the week. If you do not hear from us, please contact the ranch office. U-Turn Ranch will make every effort to accommodate allergies, however cannot guarantee that there will be no trace of the allergen in the food served.

DIRECTIONS FROM

New Hamburg – Take 7&8 west to Shakespeare. Turn left at lights. In Tavistock follow Hwy 59 south. Just past Premier John Deere turn right on Oxford Road 34. We are first on the left.

Stratford – Take 7&8 east to Shakespeare. Turn right at lights. In Tavistock follow Hwy 59 south. Just past Premier John Deere turn right on Oxford Road 34. We are first on the left.

Woodstock – Take Hwy 59 North to Tavistock. Minutes past Hickson turn left on Oxford Road 34. We are the first on the left right across from Premier John Deere.

LICE CHECKS

A lice check is done on all of our ranchers, the Monday morning of registration. Please be advised that if there are any lice or nits discovered, the rancher will be sent home to be treated and than allowed back to camp once their heads are clean. If there is anything that we are unsure of on camper's head, we require that public health clears them before returning. There are no refunds for these situations. U-turn Ranch strongly encourage parents to check before coming.

CANTEEN

The Canteen will be open everyday for the campers to purchase a snack. The Canteen includes items such as chocolate bars, chips, candy, and pop. Some healthy items will be available as well.

New this year – the price per day will include a drink and snack from the tuck shop. Due to majority of campers using the entire amount, there will be no refunds issued at the end of the week.

WHAT TO BRING!!!

1. Warm cloths for outdoor activities – part of the day will be outside.
2. 2 pairs of extra socks
3. An extra change of clothes
4. Rubber boots and rain coat
5. A closed toed shoe/boot with a minimum 1.5 cm heel for riding.
6. Running Shoes - Indoor shoes
7. Water bottle

A space will be provided for your camper to store their items for the day or week. Items may be left from day to day.

Please do not send technology or money with campers as we cannot ensure it will be safe or not lost during the day.

MEALS

Lunch will be provided. Day campers will have the option of going to the Canteen to purchase an afternoon snack. Please do not send food along with your camper due to food allergies, unless previously arranged.
