ordinance no. /-94 (1994)

AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING THE SPEED RESTRICTIONS ON ANDERSON ROAD

The Town Board of the Town of Farmington does hereby ordain as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> No person shall drive a vehicle at a speed in excess of the following limits: 35 miles per hour on Anderson Road from its intersection with U.S.H. 10 northeasterly to Larson Road.

<u>Section 2.</u> Standard signs giving notice of such speed limit, conforming to the rules of the Department of Transportation, shall be placed and maintained by the Town of Farmington.

Section 3. Any person violating this ordinance may be required to forfeit not less than \$30.00 nor more than \$300.00, as provided in Sec. 346.60, Wis. Stats., which is adopted by reference. The Deposit Schedule for Uniform State Traffic Offenses shall determine the amount of the permitted bond or deposit.

 $\underline{\text{Section 4.}}$ This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication according to law.
