From the Pastor's Desk

Dear brothers and sisters,

We are entering summer and a new time in which the parish is reopening little by little so that we can once again worship together in our beloved church. And the Gospel of this Sunday speaks about receiving people in our lives. It is interesting that Jesus when he sends his apostles tells them that whoever receives them receives ME. That is a very strong statement and further he says: "whoever rejects you rejects ME." Imagine every time we welcome someone sent by God, we welcome God and every time we reject someone sent by God, we reject God. And who is the person sent by God. Those that come into your life every day, your spouse, your child, your coworker, your boss, your friend, the annoying neighbor, the poor... in all of them Jesus is coming to visit you. This is the great thing, the other is Christ and we can welcome Christ in the other.

This seems to contrast with the first part of the Gospel that says to HATE father, mother, children, siblings, etc. However, it is not a contradiction, we need to HATE the idea of how father, mother, children, siblings, etc.... should be and welcome the ones we have loving them. Sometimes we need to reject the ideals they have given us, so that we can truly love them and be free.

As we start this summer, we are welcoming Fr. Preston Perez as our parochial vicar for the summer (let us pray that it would be for longer). Also, the daily mass will be moved to 12 noon. We will start with the Angelus, then Mass and some adoration until 1 pm. As you know, we still are in the ticket system and we will continue as long as we are required. "Life After the Pandemic"

The book published by the [Librería Editora Vaticana](#) contains eight interventions by the Pope in the first months of the year marked by the coronavirus pandemic. The reading is guided by the **preface of Cardinal Michael Czerny**, Under-Secretary of the Dicastery's Migrants Section for the Service of Integral Human Development, which illustrates the Pope's unitary thinking, his vision of the future of humanity, full of love and hope.

"Life after the Pandemic" is the new book published by the Vatican Publishing House, available free of charge in digital format on the Publishing House's website and on the landing page of Vatican News. It contains the reflections of Pope Francis - written and spoken texts - on the coronavirus pandemic that has spread in the human family, outlining the guidelines for a new beginning that has the taste of a rebirth.

Eight texts, dated 27 March to 22 April, which could be read as a unique development of his thought and as a rich message to humanity.
