- 1. Read over your groups script together.
- Use the Group Work Skills Tip Sheet to help your group work together well and make decisions together. For example, use the tip sheet to make decisions about who will perform each part.
- Use the Strength Triangle to help you work with others in a respectful, caring manner and to help you to problem solve.
- 4. You can use props for your performance.
- 5. When you finally perform in front of the audience, you should read from the script. That means you don't need to worry about memorising any lines. You can just focus on delivering the right voice volume, tone, facial expressions, actions and body language for your character.
- Help each other to decide on the best voice volume, tone, facial expressions, actions and body language that best match each character.
- If your group have a disagreement, use the Group Work Skills Tip Sheet or Strength Triangle to help.
