#### Notes from October AGEA meeting

We had the following speakers at our October meeting. All are running for office. Kim Burns, Republican and Sarah Lacey, Democrat are running for County Council in our district, which is District 1. Brooks Bennett, Republican is running for State Delegate in our District 31A and Scott Harmon, Democrat is running for State Senate in our district 31.

There was a discussion regarding false and negative attack mailers in this election from the Republican National Committee regarding the State Delegate race.

Corporal Bethea from the Hammonds Lane police station reminded everyone that we are all part of the police's ears and eyes. If you see something, please call the police station and report it. He also reminded us that we should all be aware of our surroundings when we are out. He went on to say he is not trying to scare anyone and that if you walk with purpose, stay off your mobile phone and notice your surroundings, you are less likely to be a victim of crime.

The issue with the intersection of Ritchie Highway and Cresswell was discussed. There are drivers that do not heed the No Turning sign on Ritchie Highway onto Cresswell. There is a No Parking sign on the south side of Cresswell in the block closest to Ritchie. Corporal Bethea will have his officers in the area keep an eye on the illegal parking and will ticket those that park there. Cars may be towed as well.
