From the Pastor's Desk

Dear brothers and sisters,

There is an ancient Christian story about Saint Joseph and the Virgin Mary that goes like this: After the dream where the angel reveals to Joseph that Mary has conceived by the Holy Spirit, Joseph goes to Mary's house and asks her why she did not tell him anything. He would have believed her. The answer of Mary was, because who am I to interfere in the relationship between God and you; if had not told you yet, I could not tell you. I bring this story because we have a tendency to want God and other people explain everything to us and we want that it fits to our ideas. Somethings cannot be explained only with reason. As you know this last week, I was in the funeral of a friend of mine that was killed in the line of duty. Reason alone cannot explain it. In front of certain events of our lives, in front of some tragedies there is no other answer than to wait for God to reveal the rest of His plan. And this calls for faith. Imagine Joseph, alone, betrothed and finds out his love is pregnant and is not his. How to understand, how to explain? Only God has an answer and we need to learn to trust even when we do not understand.

I want to wish you all a very Merry Christmas! May this child born in Bethlehem bring you joy and peace. Remember to look at the bulletin for the schedule and that we will be closed December 24, 25 and 26.


