I have enjoyed traveling the state listening how each auxiliary supports veterans and their families. I have learned so much from you, I see how much you all care for our veterans active and retired.

From reading all your reports, I see how much you have done this year with aid to veterans and families. Here are our figures for this year.

We had 16 auxiliaries that hosted/co-hosted with the VFW Post fundraising activities for National Veterans Service.

We had 18 auxiliaries that hosted/co-hosted with the VFW Post fundraising activities for VFW Veterans and Military Support Programs.

We had 23 auxiliaries that participated in and/or sponsored events or projects for homeless veterans.

We had 26 auxiliaries that provided direct aid to veterans, active-duty service members and/or families.

Total monetary value of donations and goods/services provided. \$88,421.68.

Total monetary donations provided. \$52,854.35.
