## Driving directions from Biarritz-Bayonne Airport (70km, travel time approximately 50 mins)

- 1. At the first roundabout take the third exit onto Boulevard Marcel Dassault
- 2. At the second roundabout again take the third exit onto Boulevard Marcel Dassault
- 3. At the third roundabout take the fourth exit to merge on to the A63 toward Bayonne and
- 4. Keep left and merge on to the A63 toward Bordeaux and Bayonne
- 5. After approx. 10km take exit 5.1 towards Pau, Toulouse and merge on to the A64 and continue for 50km
- 6. Take Exit 7 towards Salies de Bearn and Mauleon
- 7. At the roundabout take the first exit on to D430
- In approx. 4km at the next roundabout take the second exit onto Avenues des Docteurs Foix
- 9. Follow this road in to the Village about 1km
- 10. Rue Loumé is on the left hand side over a little bridge (Pont Loumé). At first it may look like pedestrian access only, but you can drive over the little bridge (past La Terrasse restaurant).
- 11. There is a blue swinging gate which you can open and drive right to the door of #9 Rue Loumé – which will be on your right hand side with the red shutters. You can only park here temporarily to drop off your bags
- 12. Free parking is available in all streets nearby the best option until you know your way around the narrow winding streets is to go back over the bridge and park in any of the available free parking spots.
- Rue Loumé is on the left hand side over a little bridge (Pont Loumé). At first it may look like pedestrian access only, but you can drive over the little bridge (past La Terrasse restaurant).
- 14. There is a blue swinging gate which you can open and drive right to the door of #9 Rue Loumé – which will be on your right hand side with the red shutters. You can only park here temporarily to drop off your bags
- 15. Free parking is available in all streets nearby the best option until you know your way around the narrow winding streets is to go back over the bridge and park in any of the available free parking spots.
