

120 years ago - the Cannon River, Welch and Prairie Island churches consolidated to become one parish <u>but</u> continued as three separate congregations in 1899. Images of the three churches can be found on a commemorative plate.

Back in 1877 the Vasa, Welch and Cannon River churches met to consolidate congregations to no, avail.

Early in 1960 a resolution by the Prairie Island congregation to consolidate with the Swedish Evangelical Lutheran church of Welch (or Welch Lutheran as it had come to be more commonly known) was
