Old Business

President Overstreet reviewed the Lily Lake Cemetery status for Trustee Florian who asked for an update. (reiteration from last meeting): Currently, the Lily Lake Cemetery is privately owned. The Campton Township Cemetery Board turned down the request to assume the Lily Lake Cemetery. At this time, it's not feasible for the Village to assume the Cemetery and all its responsibilities. The Village has no Public Works employees who can help manage the property nor the staff to handle the paperwork and funeral scheduling. President Overstreet is working with the Township Supervisor and Open Spaces Manager to propose assistance to the Lily Lake Cemetery Board in order to keep the property from falling into blight.

President Overstreet shared a news report finding on Canabis sales in California claiming an increase in Black-market cannabis sales despite the legalization of the substance.
