Youth Activities Policies

- Every camper be registered online by parent/guardian with fees paid or payment arranged before attending camp.
- Copy of insurance card can be brought at time of drop-off.
- We hold a CLOSED CAMP policy which means staff and campers must remain at the activity or campsite for the duration of the camp. Any questions regarding policy may be directed to Camp Directors and Mission Center Staff.
