Paris and Washington, D.C. -UN Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) Director General Irina Bokova & Goodwill Ambassador Herbie Hancock announce the 5th annual International Jazz Day, which will be celebrated around the world on April 30, 2016. President Barack Obama and First Lady Michelle Obama will host an All-Star Global Concert at the White House on April 29th to be broadcast on International Jazz Day as a one-hour primetime ABC television special, "Jazz at the White House," on Saturday evening, April 30 and also streamed on the UNESCO, U.S. State Dept. and White House websites.

The concert will feature artists from around the world paying tribute to the truly American art form of jazz. Each year on April 30th in partnership with the Thelonious Monk Institute of Jazz, International Jazz Day highlights the power of jazz as a force for freedom and creativity, promotes intercultural dialogue through respect and understanding, and unites people from all corners of the globe. It is recognized on the official calendars of both UNESCO and the United Nations.


