The TRUTH about the CHURCH

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or every promise that God makes to mankind, the Devil develops a cheap counterfeit to distract and lure "man" away from the truth. The doctrine concerning "the church" is just one example.

As surely as there are "false" prophets, "false" teachers and "false" brethren, there is such a thing as a "false" church.

When Jesus said, "... I will build my church..." (Matthew 16:18), he was not referring to a **VISIBLE** church, but an INVISIBLE church, a group of "called out ones." God



deals with "invisibility." "For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse" (Romans 1:20). They are "understood" by faith.

Because Satan appeals to man's **five senses**: touch, taste, feel, sight and hearing, it's easier for man to trust in himself, instead of having "faith in God."

"Man" has perverted the "right ways" of the Lord, and has changed the "truth" of God into a lie, building places of worship, and calling them "churches."

The true church is not a building; neither is it a place of worship, nor a "place" at all. The church of the living God is the *invisible* body of Christ, made up of bornagain men and women. For Christ "... is the head of the

body, the church..." (Col. 1:18) "for we are members of his body, of his flesh, and of his bones" (Ephesians 5:30).

Jesus explained the "place to worship" when he spoke to a woman of Samaria at Jacob's well. The woman said to Jesus, "Our fathers worshipped in this



mountain; and ye (Jews) say, that in Jerusalem is the place where men ought to worship...but Jesus said to her ...the hour cometh, and now IS, when the TRUE WORSHIPPERS shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth...God is a Spirit: and they that worship him MUST worship him in spirit and in truth" (John 4:21-24).

Just as there are two churches in the world, there are also two spirits in the world that guide them: "...the spirit of truth and the spirit of error" (1 John 4:6).

The Holy Spirit "... shall not speak of himself..." (John 16:13), while the spirit of error (the dove symbol) DOES.

The true church is **NOT** an organization, but a living organism, which makes up the Bride of Christ. Paul said, "This is a great mystery: but I speak concerning Christ and the church" (Ephes. 5:22-33).

We use the OLD King James Version: Amos 8:11 "Behold, the days come, saith the Lord God, that I will send a famine in the land, not a famine of bread, nor a thirst for water, but of hearing the words of the Lord:
