#### SCHOOL YEAR FEES FOR 2020 - 2021

#### TUITION / FEES

#### **Application Fee**

New students must submit a *non-refundable application fee of \$25.00* with a completed enrollment application. Re – Enrollment students must submit a *non-refundable application fee of \$25.00* with a completed re - enrollment application

#### **Registration Fee**

An interview with the student and the parents or guardian of the student will be required before final acceptance. Upon acceptance, a student must pay a non-refundable registration fee \$25.00. To secure placement for the coming year, a student must satisfy all financial obligations, including the presentation of proof of Award Scholarship Letter for the current year student will attending school and the payment of all application fees, including application, school entrance test fee, registration and curriculum fees. Scholarship student may or may not need to pay the registration, curriculum fees, etc. because it is cover by the scholarship amount awarded – each case is individually. Instead, the application fee and entrance test fee are responsibility of the student parent pay it at the moment all documents required for enrollment or re – enrollment are return to school.

#### **Curriculum Fee**

When a student's monthly installment payments are scheduled to begin in July 1, 2020 the student may include the curriculum fee (See Book Fee Chart) as part of the 11 / 10-month payment plan. Otherwise, a student's curriculum fees are due in full no later than July 30, 2020. Seats are considered forfeited by all students who fail to pay or make arrangements to pay the curriculum fee by July 30, 2020. Curriculum fee is NON-REFUNDABLE.

#### **Tuition Fee**

Private Pay/Non-Scholarship students, see administrator for pricing.

Tuition for 2020 - 2021 school year is in between \$5,125.00 - \$6,865.00 (See Tuition Chart) dividing in 11/10-month installment payments.

The first payment of the school year is due on July 1, 2020.



#### TUITION WILL NOT BE PRORATED FOR THE MONTH OF AUGUST.

Monthly tuition payments are collected by Credit Card, Cash, Money Order, Cashier Check or Personal check (personal check return have a Fee of \$35.00 and after that the student can't pay using this form of payment).

Monthly payment installments can be on the 1<sup>st</sup> or the 15<sup>th</sup> of each month beginning in July 2020 and concluding in May 2021. The agreement must be signed by June 30, 2020. Parents who opt to pay the annual tuition in full prior to July 15<sup>th</sup> will receive a 10% discount per child.

When a student (Scholarship awarded student or Private Pay) is withdrawn by the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month; the tuition is **NOT PRORATE and NON- REFUNDABLE**. Also, need to be notifying to the administration at least with 30 days in advance or the following month will be charge in junction with the \$300.00 fee for withdraw the student before the End of the Year.

**NO REFUNDS** will be given on Application Fee; Registration Fee; Month Tuition and Curriculum Fee. **NO STUDENT** will be permitted to graduate or report cards will give until all fee's student owe are paid in full.

Raising Knowledge Academy accept the following Scholarships Program: McKay; Step Up Financial; Step Up Gardiner; Step Up HOPE; AAA Scholarship Financial and AAA Scholarship Gardiner.

Students who rely on an external scholarship for the payment of tuition and fees may not attend classes until the Admission Department receives proof that the scholarship has been awarded and all financial arrangements with the school are completed. The student's seat is not reserved until all financial obligations are met.

#### Students Enrolling Late (after July 30th)

Installment payments for the school year are made from July 2020 through May 2021. Consequently, all application, registration, and curriculum fees are due immediately when a student enrolls after July 30, 2020. Additionally, a portion of the annual tuition will become due immediately when a student enrolls late. Students cannot attend classes without satisfying these requirements.

#### **Additional Expenses**

All Students are required to purchase uniforms through GQ Uniforms.

There are additional costs associated with graduation (Prom-Night, Senior Trip and Universal Grad batch, and Field Trips).

Other fees apply if a student wishes to purchase class pictures or yearbooks or if a student chooses to participate in team sports, field trips, the annual high school prom, or Before & After – School Care.

Also, Absences to class without any medical excuse could cause financial expenses at school. Because after five absences in the same semester the parent or guardian of the student must be responsible for the payment subtracted by the scholarship to the school in case this event happened. It is therefore that parents are asked to bring a medical excuse every time the student is absent.

#### **Late Fee**

Any Payment that is received five (5) days after the due date must include a \$25.00 fee for late charge; this is including the scholarship awarded students.



#### **Tutoring Fee**

Tutoring is offer only for CORE classes (English, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, Reading or Writing).

All tutoring fee need to be paid BEFORE the tutoring service to the student. Student will receive half hour of tutoring per day in a weekly form. To cancel the tutoring section; parent need to notify in writing at least with two weeks in advance to the Tutoring Lead. If student need to return to take tutoring student parent need to notify with two weeks in advance to open a space to the student.
