Ordinance 06-19-17A(2017) An Ordinance Establishing a No Loitering/No Smoking Sign on Taylor Court

The Town Board of the Town of Farmington, Waupaca County do ordain as follows:

Section 1: The Town Board of the Town of Farmington, Waupaca County has the specific authority under s.349.13 Wis Stats to adopt this ordinance.

Section 2. This ordinance provides for the regulation of the stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles on town highways in the town as follows:

A. The stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles on Taylor Court in the Town of Farmington is subject to the following restrictions and limitations:

1) Due to health and safety and no garbage receptacle available, loitering and smoking will not be allowed from non - Taylor Court residents.

Section 3. Penalties. Any person violating this ordinance shall be required to forfeit \$10.00 plus costs. This ordinance shall be enforced through the Memorandum of Understanding with the Waupaca County Sheriff department. The cash deposit that the alleged violator may make in lieu of a court appearance is \$150.10 which includes the applicable forfeiture, court costs and penalty assessment. If court costs and penalty assessments increase in the future, the cash deposit shall be adjusted accordingly without the need to amend this ordinance.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication according to law, allowing adequate time for erection of sign(s).
