ORDINANCE NO. <u>08-20-12 (2012)</u>

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PRIVATE BURIALS

The Town Board of Town of Farmington does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to prohibit private burials in the Town.

SECTION 2. Authority. This ordinance is based on the police power of the Town Board, including §60.22, 60.23 and Subch. II of Ch. 157, Wis. Stats.

SECTION 3. Prohibition on Private Burials. No person may bury the body of a deceased individual unless the burial of the human remains is in a cemetery established and authorized under state statutes and Waupaca County zoning ordinances.

SECTION 4. Penalty. Any violation of this ordinance is a public nuisance. An action to enjoin a violation of this ordinance may be commenced and prosecuted by the Town of Farmington. Any person violating this ordinance shall also forfeit up to \$500.00 for each violation, plus costs. Each day that the public nuisance exists may be considered a separate violation by the court. Any person violating this ordinance shall also be responsible for any costs to rebury the human remains in an established cemetery.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication according to law.
