$>$ All teams must check in at the registration table on the first day of the tournament for processing with their AAU cards and a copy of the birth certificate or report card for each player.)
$>$ Each team will be given individual player passes along with three coaches passes, only. All passes must be presented at time of entry. If a badge is lost the daily fee will be applied. NO EXCEPTIONS. It is the Coaches' responsibility to monitor the use of their team passes.
$>$ All teams MUST arrive at the gym together (Coaches and players) one hour before your first game on Friday/Saturday. (Upon arrival at the gym report to Commissioner Lynn Smack for instructions)
$>$ At the end of each game coaches must report to the commissioner to receive their next game assignment, time and location. NO EXCEPTIONS.
$>$ Teams will be allowed five minutes to warm up if time permits.
$>$ There is a NO TOLERANCE POLICY, profanity, fighting, or any other act of disrespect or violence will not be tolerated. Players, coaches and bench personnel, who participate in fighting will be disqualified and banned from further participation in the tournaments.
$>$ If a player, coach or spectator is asked to leave the building for any reason, the tournament crowd control representative will escort the person out of the building, and they will not be allowed to participate in the team's next game.
$>$ Coaches will be held responsible for the behavior and conduct of their players, parents and fans, Security measures will take place if necessary.
$>$ The Home team will be the Scorekeeper. The Visiting team will be responsible for running the time clock. NO EXCEPTIONS
$>$ Participants, ages 9 through 19 will play under The National High School Federation Rules. Exception: On the 10th team foul this will become bonus, Instead of 7th team foul. The 10th team foul will be two shots. The Clock will stop on all free throw attempts; once the team lines up on the foul line the clock will begin.
$>$ Running time will be in effect except for the last minute of first half and the last two minutes of the game. At any point of the game if your team falls behind by 25 points the clock will run and will only stop on time outs. It will go back to a normal game clock if the lead falls below twenty points.
> Ages 9-12 will play 14-minute halves. Ages 13-19 will play 16-minute halves
$>$ Only 3 full time outs per game.
$>$ Three-minute overtime period for ages 13-19. Two-minute overtime period for ages 9-12.
$>$ Home teams will set to the left of the score table.
> Home teams will wear light color jersey and provide the game ball.
> Teams MUST provide their own balls.
> Coaches are responsible for assuring players bench areas are cleaned up after each game.
$>$ Coaches are required to ensure the removal of all trash in bleachers, players benches and around trash cans. All trash must be placed in trash cans provided.
