From Fr. Francisco 's Desk

Dear brothers and sisters,

"Holy Church of God, you cannot do your mission, you cannot carry out your mission in the world, except through the family and its mission."

This were the words of Saint John Paul II on the Feast of the Holy Family in 1988. We need to rediscover urgently the meaning of the family and its mission in the world. The family of father, mother, children – a communion of persons that learn to love each other. In the book of Genesis, we find the creation story and it says that we are created in the "image and likeness of God" but what does that mean? How are we like God? The answer is in the communion of persons. God, who is Trinity (three persons that love each other so much that are one being) and we are capable of communion. Father, mother, children can have communion among them in Christ. That is why the Sacrament of Marriage is so important because it puts Christ in the middle of two very different people (Husband and Wife) and makes them capable of becoming one in communion and from this communion children can be born. That is why the family is so important because in the Christian Family we can see a reflection of the Trinitarian Love of God. As we have just celebrated the birth of the Savior, let us pray for our families that so many times are wounded by so many things and ask God to restore them to the mission He has intended for them.

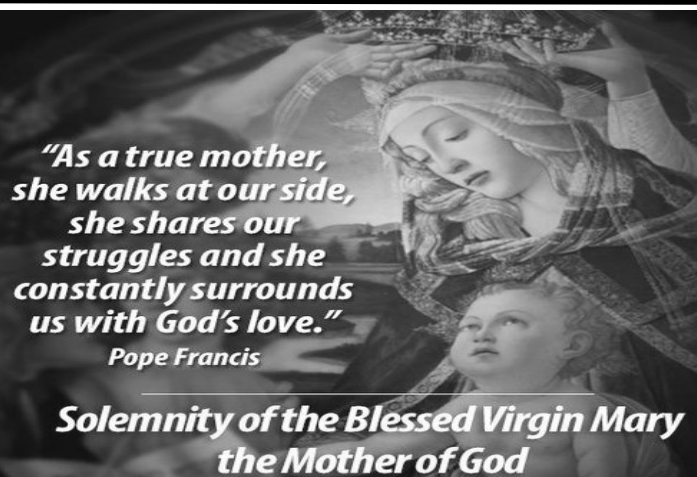
