Herrmann vs Thurston

This month, on August 17, 2019, there will be a playing card throwing competition at Germantown Presbyterian Church. This will be only the 3rd time that this will be presented in the Memphis area. Over a hundred years ago, the great magicians Alexander Herrmann and Howard Thurston were skilled as card throwers. They also had cards especially printed up that would be tossed out into the audience as souvenirs. When I say, "tossed out", I mean thrown out all the way from the theater stage to the upper balcony. Both Herrmann and Thurston had their own techniques of throwing a card, but both methods were extremely effective.

At the time, Howard Thurston was known as "The King of Cards". For instance, he would point to a woman in the balcony with a large hat and have her stand. He would then take a single playing card and, with a couple of steps, he would throw that card upwards toward the woman, landing the card onto her hat! Alexander Herrmann also was quite skilled in the art of card throwing. He would accomplish his feat by throwing a single card across the stage at a chosen spot on a wooden target. One story tells of Herrmann throwing a second card at the target, then miraculously "splitting the card in half" by another thrown card. These stories are legendary, and little wonder, given their already publicized magical talent.

So, come out on August 17th at 7:00pm and help carry on this historically magical event. Cheer on your favorite card thrower. Or better yet, participate in the competition. - Continued on Page 2


