Singstreet was one of the most progressive, and most exciting, three-year-old males in France last summer, when he improved sharply in each and every start. **A winner of 3 of his 5 races** to date, Singstreet captured the **Prix Pelleas (LR)** over 2000 metres at Compiegne, having beaten subsequent G3 winner Delaware hard on the bridle by 2 lengths in the stakes quality conditions event **Prix des Vignes** over 1600 metres at Longchamp on his preceding start.

He began his career by winning over the same distance at Chantilly and was then given 43 kg by the French handicapper, who raised him to 45.5 kg after his Longchamp success, then put him right up to an impressive 51 kg (= **112 internationally**) after the Prix Pelleas (LR), an event Singstreet won **comfortably by 5 lengths** from the Andre Fabre trained Alwaab (a Listed-winner at Deauville next time out). It is rare for a horse with so little experience to break the 110 rating barrier.

After this tremendous performance, Singstreet was being prepared for the prestigious Prix Guillame d'Ornano (G2) at Deauville, but a setback ruled him out of that contest. His is in training with Mme Bollack-Badel.
