SALES CONTRACT & HEALTH WARRANTY

We first want to thank you for purchasing a pure bred puppy from Golden Guardian Kennels. A puppy is a real joy to add to the family. We at Golden Guardian Kennels take great pride in raising beautiful, healthy, well adjusted puppies. Many loving hours were spent to provide you with a healthy, happy, and well socialized puppy. We maintain an important relationship with our veterinarians, and our puppies are vet checked and health certified. In the event that a puppy should have an undiagnosed congenital defect, we at Golden Guardian Kennels have provided the buyer of our puppies with the following 1 year health guarantee.

Whether your puppy has been purchased as a show or companion dog/puppy the commitments of this document must be fulfilled in order for our health guarantee to be valid and binding. Initially, the buyer must take the puppy to a licensed veterinarian at the buyer's expense within 5 days of receiving the puppy. The veterinarian must perform a complete health exam and a copy of the veterinarian's report must be sent back to us (Golden Guardian Kennels) for this contract to be valid. If within this time the buyer's veterinarian discovers a congenital defect that will severely interfere with the life function and mobility of the puppy, the buyer will immediately contact Golden Guardian Kennels and will send a certified statement from the veterinarian to this effect. This includes severe hip dysplasia and heart problems of a severe and life threatening nature.

If this puppy is returned for replacement or refund, the seller will either refund the purchase price only (no veterinarian fees will be refunded) or if another puppy is available then an exchange for a puppy of equal value will be made. In case of refund, the puppy is to be returned to the seller in good condition along with the registration papers. Replacement puppy will be mutually agreed upon by both parties and will be of comparable quality. It is understood that the replacement puppy may not be from the exact parents of the original puppy.

There is no guarantee or warranty that the buyers will be able to show or breed the puppy regardless of show or breed potentials. Seller assumes no liability for the adult size of this puppy.

Seller assumes no responsibility for this puppy after leaving the premises, medical expenses, landlord approval, allergies to animals, disagreement of family, or any other reason other than stated. Buyer is aware that owning a puppy means trips to the veterinarian and understands that he/she will be responsible for all payments. Also be sure to puppy proof its new home as a puppy will chew and destroy all kinds of things at the buyer's expense.

This guarantee does not include coccidia, giardia, and kennel cough, which are common in puppies that are shipped and usually caused by bacteria. Kennel cough is self limiting and like the common cold, it must run its course. Full recovery is expected and kennel cough on its own is not life threatening. There are certain disorders that may be caused by environmental factors, such as allergies, thyroid dysfunction, demodectic mange and other autoimmune disorders that are not covered by the guarantee. Any physical problem which is the result of injury is not covered under this guarantee. This guarantee applies to the original owner only and is not transferable to a second party.

This is to certify that the buyer agrees to never sell or give the puppy to any pet shop, pet farm or similar institutions. If for some reason the buyer cannot keep the puppy or wishes to sell/give it away, the buyer will contact the seller first to make sure the seller does not want to purchase the puppy/dog.

Our puppies are raised on a rigorous schedule of shots and wormings. In turn it is your responsibility to continue this level of care, adhering to regular scheduled shots and wormings in order to keep your puppy in optimal health. Prompt continuing veterinarian care is a commitment you make to the puppy you have purchased. Golden Guardian Kennels appreciates and values your commitment, but cannot be responsible for veterinarian bills that may occur due to your failing to continue this level of care.

Puppies/dogs when introduced into new surroundings are sometimes likely to exhibit shyness or even inactivity. In some instances, they refuse food or water until feeling more comfortable with their surroundings. After becoming adapted to the new environment, they will readily accept you as their new master and the food you offer. Your care, patience, and attention will aid in overcoming the shyness to their new quarters.

Your breeder is always willing to give advice and help in any reasonable way in that the welfare of puppy is of primary concern.
