15 Mr. Morris.

16 JUDGE HUNN: Counsel, I'm  
17 sure you must be aware that parties are  
18 exempt from the rule. Parties and party  
19 representatives are always exempted from  
20 the rule and are never required to leave  
21 the room when others are placed on the  
22 rule. Therefore, your request is denied.
