Membership Meeting
Minutes - October 3, 2015

Treasurers Report: Balance of \$5,295. Winck Survey, Lake Restoration treatment, Insurance Center liability, General Meeting/Picnic, mailing expenses. & PO Box rent have all been paid. We received a \$1,000 donation for the Clean Water fund.

Membership: We have a total of 91 members. This is up one from last year. A review of records show a few of our past members did not join this year. We will address this at our next board meeting when a complete set of records will be available.

Lake Survey: Winck has completed the survey and will forward results to us this month. The board will meet and review results. If any action is needed that we feel would be impossible for our association to handle we will contact the watershed district for assistance. The survey will show beneficial native milfoil as well as any invasive non-native milfoil such as Eurasian. Any increases or decreases in vegetation will be noted. The board hopes to meet Oct 31st or Nov 14th with Winck Rep Les Bowl.

Zebra Mussels: Director Boie will chair this committee. Presently we have 5 testing sites and we hope to increase this to 10 next year. Any concerns or findings should be directed to Dave for proper reporting. Landing inspection for invasive plants and mussels were discussed. If we would like more hours of coverage at the landings it would be our expense for training and inspection hours.

No Wake: This restriction is put into play when the watershed district closes the culvert on the NE end. Chair Sedey is informed and in-turn he notifies the county. The county then posts signs at the landing that the No Wake rule is in play. There has been very little problem this past season and as many homeowners have ignored the rule as have visiting boaters. Flyers may be used to communicate the status change with homeowners in the future.

Annual Meeting/Picnic: The entire board was very pleased with the turnout for mt/picnic. We will reserve the pavilion, upper & lower, for Aug 20th 2016 and once again combine the two. Peterson will contact city.

Newsletter: The Fall issue should be out this month. Advertising discussed. Director Amy Miller, who will shortly move to Clearwater Lake with her family, has offered to continue programming the letter for the printer.
