*"It has become a tradition at Southeast to close every assembly with the singing of the Southeast Chant. Miss Lucy B. Neville, a former English teacher at Southeast, adapted these words from a poem by Chaucer, for she felt that they stated the ideals of a true knight. Mr. Ben Markley then set the words to appropriate music.*

*This year, as a special Round Table project, the words of the chant were painted on a large shield. This shield was hung in the gymnasium so that students from other schools as well as our own would be reminded of the Southeast Code of Knighthood."*
