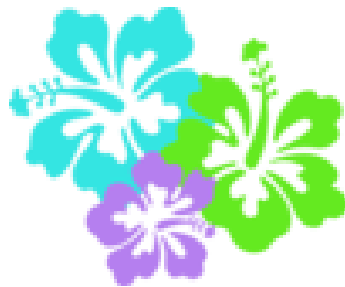
Recent Events

Tufts Medical Center Dedicates the Mary Jo Brown Admitting Department on October 4, 2012

At a ceremony attended by family, close friends and colleagues, Eric Beyer officially named the Admitting Department at Tufts Medical Center the Mary Jo Brown Admitting Department, as her husband Tom and daughter Christina unveiled her picture and a memorial plaque in the Department's waiting room. The entrance on Proger One also denotes the special honor with an elegant engraved name plate, "Mary Jo Brown Admitting Office".



A cocktail reception followed the dedication and more than 100 people whose life was touched by Mary Jo stopped by to share memories and smiles and to thank Tufts for creating this lasting memorial. Mary Jo was the face of Tufts, often the first person hospitalized patients and their families encountered in their journey to better health. She was quick to hold a hand, dry a tear as well as offer words of encouragement by telling patients there was no better hospital in the world than Tufts Medical Center - and she really believed that. Mary Jo's compassionate and caring personality gave strength and comfort to so many people over her 35 years of service. As someone was overheard saying, "It's hard to forget someone who gave us so much to remember."
