The release of her first eBook and paperback, *Yesterday's Tomorrow* was released in December 2016. *Yesterday's Tomorrow*, a first-hand account of her own suffering of abuse as a child. After finding the courage to speak out about the pain she endured, Danielle is now using her experience to inspire others to do the same. Her passion for child advocacy led her to volunteer with Franklin County Children Services.

In November 2016, she was sworn in as a Guardian Ad Litem with CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocate). CASA was a safe haven for her as a child when she was removed from her home because of abuse and neglect. She is “for the child” and is excited to volunteer her time and be a voice for a child is the founder of the “Don’t Be Quiet” movement, an organization with a mission to help victims of child abuse and neglect, domestic violence, sexual assault, and suicide.

In April 2018, she released a Short Film by the same name that gives a visual account of her book and walks you through the challenge of going from victim to victor! She is a passionate speaker that brings people together through shared experiences, taking away the struggle of beginning the healing process alone.
