From the Pastor's Desk

Dear brothers and sisters,

I am writing this column today as we remember a very somber day, September 11, 2001. Everyone who lived that day remembers where we were and how it affected us. I lost a good friend that day, a firefighter who was off duty but felt the duty as ironic as it sounds to go into his fire station to go look and save those who were stranded and in danger. Very similar to how the Gospel starts: the good shepherd looking for the lost sheep. And this is the role of the Church to go look for those who are suffering or lost. We are not a Church that does not get dirty. Pope Francis repeats that we are a Church that has no problem like the Good Shepherd to get dirty. He has called priests to have the smell of the sheep, not to be so inaccessible that no one can talk to him. But it is not only the priests or the nuns, it is an invitation for each one of us who are baptized to bring Christ to the other. This Gospel challenges us, it is a push to get out of our comfort zone and to bring Christ with us.



We are starting today our CCD program, another way to bring Christ. I invite you to be involved in the formation of faith of your children but not only the parents, it takes a village, a whole parish, to transmit faith to the next generation. So, please be involved and help as much as you can. I need to thank all the volunteers in our CCD and RCIA programs that give so generously to our parish of the time, talent and even treasure – God will repay you a hundred-fold. We are about to finish our parking lot... let us take care of it.

Therefore, as we start this new time in the parish, I invite you to also take part in our Bible Study, Prayer Group, Bonds of Marian Love, Talleres de Oración y Vida, Youth Ministry, CCD and so many other spiritualities that will start coming to make our parish a vibrant one.


